





Third/Additional Dose Guidance

Third/Additional Dose: Given at least 28 days after completing the initial series to those immunocompromised.	Pfizer Recipients	Moderna Recipients
Can receive third/additional dose		


Currently, CDC is recommending that moderately to severely immunocompromised people receive an additional dose. This includes people who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids (20mg prednisone or equivalent) or other drugs that may suppress your immune response

People should talk to their healthcare provider about their medical condition, and whether getting an additional dose is appropriate for them.



Booster Dose Guidance

Booster Dose: Given at least 6 months after completing the initial series to those 65 and older; 18+ who have underlying medical conditions, 18+ who work in high-risk settings, 18+ who live in high-risk settings.	Pfizer Recipients	Moderna Recipients
Can receive booster dose		

Currently, CDC is recommending the following occupations at increased risk for COVID-19 (List can be updated in the future):

- First responders (healthcare workers, firefighters, police, congregate care staff)
- Education staff (teachers, support staff, daycare workers)
- Food and agriculture workers
- Manufacturing workers
- Corrections workers
- U.S. Postal Service workers
- Public transit workers
- Grocery store workers
