What is Narcan™?

Narcan™ (naloxone) is an opiate antidote. Opioids include heroin and prescription pain pills such as oxycodone, codeine and morphine. Narcan is a prescription medication that blocks the effects of opioids and reverses an overdose.

Who can be prescribed Narcan™?

Trained individuals are allowed to possess and administer Narcan to a person having an overdose.
