Scheduling a COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment in VAMS

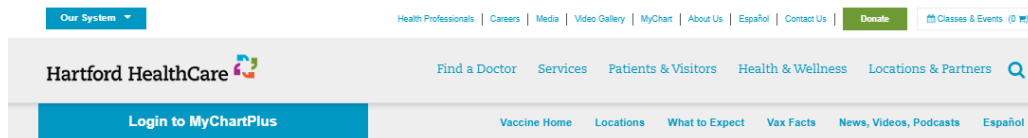

Other Scheduling Information

Residents and Staff of Congregate Settings
Vaccination programs for residents and staff of congregate settings are being coordinated by State and local health departments.

Educators and Child Care Providers
By March 1st, you should expect to hear from your employer and/or your local health director about options for appointments to receive your first dose.

Homebound Individuals
Individuals who are medically or physically unable to leave their home to receive a COVID-19 vaccine can register their need for in-home vaccination.
