TATTOO PARLORS

13.1 ANNUAL FILING FEE REQUIRED

All tattoo parlors shall file an annual fee for establishment registration. A registration form is to be filled out with documentation from a supervising physician attesting to the knowledge and clinical competence of the person or persons engaged in tattooing for the establishment (amended 3/03 in accordance with Section 19a-92a-1 of the Connecticut Public Health Code).

Further that the physician shall physically appear at the business establishment to perform training and his or her certification shall have the original signatures of those who have been trained and their printed names on the same form as the physician's signature.

13.2 PENALTY FEE

Due to the extreme danger of infection to the population, failure to provide documentation by February 1 annually, along with the filing fee, shall result in the immediate closure of the tattoo establishment. A penalty fee of \$500 and all legal costs for Marshal service shall be paid prior to approval for re-opening once the proper documentation is submitted to the health department.
