Bed Bugs

Description

- Adults are apple-seed in size
- Color is brown
- They walk and do not jump or fly
- They are flat and oval in shape
- They are very shy timid insects

Management

- 1. DON'T PANIC!
- **FIRST** correctly identify the insect 2.
- 3. GO TO www.ct.gov/caes/ccabb for information
- **NEVER** rely on "bites" to diagnose bed bugs 4.
- **REPORT** bed bugs. Seek help promptly 5.
- **NEVER** self treat 6.
- **USE** a certified professional pest 7. management professional to inspect & treat
- **CLEAN** and eliminate clutter as part of bed 8. bug control
